

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Place containers at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Not the night before.
- Place containers three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward the street. The arrow on the lid pointing to the centre of the road.
- Place containers at least three (3) feet from obstructions such as cars, trees, fences, mailboxes, garage doors. Our trucks need clear access to empty containers.
- Place wheels as close to the curb as possible. On the roadway, not the sidewalk.
- Write your address on your cart.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES FOR GARBAGE AND ORGANIC SERVICING:

- **Always bag all garbage before placing in cart.** Residents are responsible for cleaning up any loose garbage scattered as the result of animals, wind or vandalism.
- Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust and extinguished ashes.
- Maximum weight is 20kg/44 lbs. Overweight and overflowing containers for organics will not be accepted. Lid must close completely.
- For garbage, limit is 1 cart bi-weekly (STRICTLY ENFORCED).
- You may put up to 2 extra bags if accompanied by extra bag tags – available for purchase at City Hall & Shoppers Drug Mart for \$5.
- Do not put soil/dirt or rocks in organics carts. Servicing will resume after these items are removed.

NOT ACCEPTED These items are not accepted in your garbage cart

- Recyclables.
- Dirt, rocks, gyproc, cement, or steel
- Building/demolition material
- Liquids
- Uncontained animal waste
- Any hazardous or noxious matter
- Medical Waste
- Electronics
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- Clean wood
- Food and yard waste
- Styrofoam
- Paint
- Batteries

FOOD AND YARD WASTE

Accepted items in organic carts

Food Scraps



Meat, fish, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers

Food-Soiled Uncoated Paper



Coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, uncoated paper (non-shiny), soiled paper bags, paper towels, paper napkins, non-coated paper plates

Plants, Flowers and Yard Debris



Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, grass clippings, weeds, twigs, leaves, branches (under 4 feet long, 4 inches in diameter), jack-o-lanterns and holiday trees (no decorations or flocking)

These items are not accepted in your food and yard waste cart
