

**CITY OF PITT MEADOWS
COMMUNITY AMENITY CONTRIBUTIONS RESERVE FUND
BYLAW NO. 2759, 2017**

A Bylaw to establish a Capital Reserve Fund to be used for the provision of public amenities consistent with the Residential Community Amenity Contribution Policy C091

WHEREAS, Council has endorsed a Community Amenity Contribution Policy which identifies various amenities which may be provided with the Community Amenity Contributions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Pitt Meadows in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the **City of Pitt Meadows Community Amenity Contributions Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 2759, 2017.**
2. There shall be and is hereby established a reserve fund under the provisions of Section 188(1) of the Community Charter, to be known as Community Amenity Contributions Reserve Fund.
3. Monies may be paid into this Reserve Fund from Amenity Contributions made under the Community Amenity Contribution Policy C091 or as otherwise authorized in the City's Financial Plan and from the other Reserve Funds as authorized by bylaw.
4. Money in the Community Amenity Contributions Reserve Fund shall only be used to provide amenities as detailed in the Council Policy, Community Amenity Contribution Policy. These amenities include any of the following:
 - a) Community Civic Facility;
 - b) Public Art;
 - c) Acquisition of land for the provision of:
 - i. Affordable or special needs housing;
 - ii. Parks;
 - iii. Trails;
 - iv. Significant ecological features
 - d) Park, trail, or sports facility or field construction or maintenance;
 - e) Affordable or special needs housing units;
 - f) Heritage conservation;
 - g) Conservation of significant ecological features;
 - h) Other projects as identified by Council
