Practice Safe Boating This Summer

When you are out on the water this summer, make sure you and your passengers are practicing boating safety. No matter how much experience you have, it's always a good idea to review boating safety rules before heading out.

Follow these safety rules:

- If you cannot swim, stay out of the water.
- Wear a personal flotation device at all times; don't assume you'll have time to put on a lifejacket in an emergency.
- Watch your speed on and off the water. Speed is a major contributor to incidents on the roadways and on the water.
- Alcohol, marijuana and boating don't mix. Impaired driving laws are the same for operating a boat as they are for a vehicle.

There are safety equipment rules for all types of watercrafts, from canoes to yachts. Whatever water activity you enjoy, act responsibly and stay safe.
