Local Government Elections Mail Ballot Voting

On October 15, Pitt Meadows residents will elect one mayor, six councillors and two school trustees for a four year term. This year, all registered electors can vote by mail. Request a mail ballot package at City Hall during normal office hours or online and return it in person or via mail by 8:00 p.m. on October 15. The last day to request a mail ballot be mailed to you via Canada Post is October 3. Leave extra time when mailing your completed ballot to ensure it arrives in time to be counted.
