Drive Safe in School Zones

As school resumes this month, ensure you leave extra travel time, stay focused on the road and watch for children, especially around school zones. Remember that every school day, unless otherwise posted, a 30km/h speed limit is in effect in school zones from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Follow these rules to help keep school zones safe:

- 1. Slow down and be especially careful on neighbourhood streets and around school zones. Always expect the unexpected.
- All vehicles must stop when a school bus displays flashing red warning lights and extends the stop signal arm.
- 3. Watch for children on bicycles. Young bicyclists have a tendency to dart out of driveways or into intersections without looking for traffic.
- 4. If you meet your child at the bus stop after school, wait on the side where the child will be dropped off, not across the street. Children can get so excited about seeing you that they might forget safety rules and dash across the street.
- As a pedestrian, try and make eye contact with drivers before crossing the road, and avoid becoming distracted by your mobile phone while walking.
