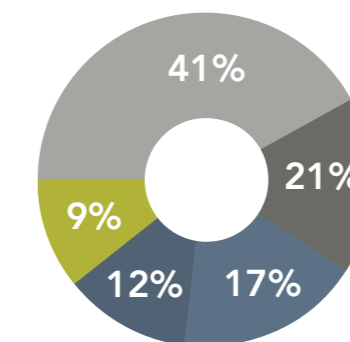
Organic Waste Collection Tonnage

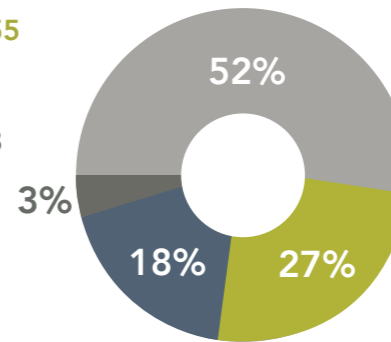
