Planning to build a deck, add a shed or make renovations? It is the property owner's responsibility to obtain a building permit from the City for a variety of projects prior to construction. Water Main Flushing

March 22 is World Water Day. Water main flushing is one of the ways the City maintains our clean drinking water. When water main flushing is happening in your neighbourhood, you may notice a temporary drop in water pressure, sediment or a discolouration in your water. The water is still safe to drink, but to correct problems with cloudy or turbid water, run your cold water for a few minutes until the water runs clear.
