Garden Etiquette, Safety and Respect

Pack out what you pack in - We encourage visitors to take all belongings with them when they leave to maintain the garden's beauty for everyone to enjoy.

Stay on the pathways - Please remain on designated trails to protect the garden's delicate plants and natural ecosystem.

No dogs or pets allowed - To preserve the sensitive ecosystem, tranquillity and safety of the garden, pets are not permitted. Working guide and service dogs are welcome on trails only.

Be mindful - Garden pathways may be uneven. Visitors using walking aids should take care and be accompanied by someone who can assist, if needed.

Wildlife in the area - This is a shared space with local wildlife. Stay aware of your surroundings and keep children close at hand.

Prohibited at all times: smoking or vaping, illicit drugs or alcohol, running on the property, pets, bicycles, scooters or other wheeled recreational devices.
