National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

The City recognized National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day to honour the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Trees were also wrapped in orange in ɣx'hék'nəs (Spirit Square) and around City Hall to spread awareness of the local community event.

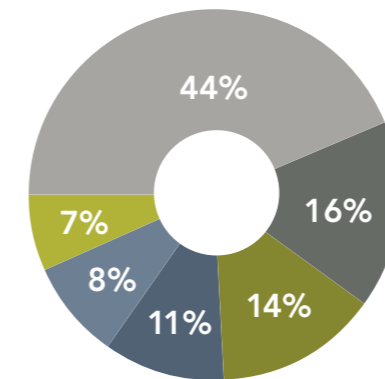

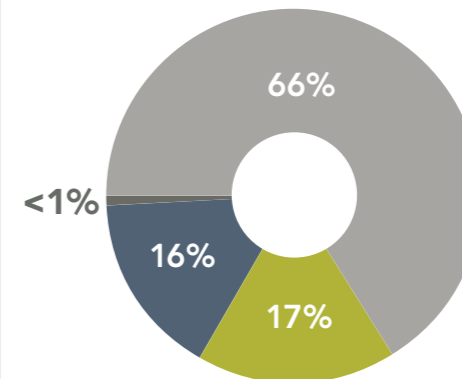
