BYLAW NOTICE ENFORCEMENT  
AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3041, 2026**

A bylaw to amend portions of the City of Pitt Meadows Bylaw Notice  
Enforcement Bylaw No. 2439, 2009

---

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the City of Pitt Meadows Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 2439, 2009;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Pitt Meadows enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 3041, 2026".
2. The City of Pitt Meadows Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 2439, 2009 is amended as follows:
