



# Application for Registration as a Non-Resident Property Elector in Pitt Meadows

**PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM**

## 1. PERSONAL INFORMATION

- Print applicant's surname and given names in full.
- Print *either* the last 6 digits of the applicant's social insurance number *or* the applicant's birthdate. This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.

## 2. RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS

- Print the applicant's residential address including street number and name, city/town and postal code.

## 3. MAILING ADDRESS

- If different from the residential address, print the applicant's mailing address including street number and name, city/town and postal code.

## 4. PROPERTY FOR WHICH VOTING ENTITLEMENT IS BEING SOUGHT

- Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in Pitt Meadows for which voting entitlement is being sought. The applicant *must* attach satisfactory proof that they are entitled to register as an elector for this property (e.g. certificate of title, property tax notice, property assessment notice, etc.)
- If the land title registration of the real property in relation to which a person is registering under this section indicates that there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the real property, the applicant must complete the "Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form" (Form 7-3) and submit it with this Application Form. The person may only register as a non-resident property elector with the written consent of the majority of the property owners (the applicant may be one of those signatories).

## 5. SIGNATURES

- The applicant must declare that they meet all the requirements listed in this section to register as a non-resident property elector.
- The applicant must sign the application form in the presence of a witness.
- The witness to the applicant's signature must sign the application form and print their residential address. (*address is not required if the witness is an election official*)

## 6. ELECTION OFFICIAL USE

- If the applicant is registering at time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity are required.
- If the applicant *does not* have documentation showing residency, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) are still required and the person must make a solemn declaration as to their place of residence.
- The type of identification documents provided (not the numbers or other information from the documents) must be included here.

BY SIGNING AND SUBMITTING THIS FORM, YOU ARE DECLARING THAT YOU MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS TO BE REGISTERED AS A NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR:

1. You are a Canadian Citizen;
2. You are age 18 or older, or, you will be turning 18 on or before General Voting Day;
3. You have been a resident of British Columbia for the past 6 months;
4. You do not qualify as a resident elector within Pitt Meadows;
5. You have been an owner of the real property identified above for at least the past 30 days;
6. You have obtained the consent of a majority of the owners of the above described property to be registered as the non-resident property elector for the property;
7. You are not currently registered as a non-resident property elector with respect to any other property within Pitt Meadows; and
8. You are not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

6. ELECTION OFFICIAL USE ONLY	
The Local Government Act requires applicants registering at the time of voting to produce two documents as evidence of their identity and place of residence, at least one of which must include the applicant's signature.
