Dear Mayor and Council,

We attach herewith a complete Petition of 19 pages and 163 Signatures regarding the North Lougheed Area Plan.

A recurring issue noted by nearly everyone signing the petition is a lack of newspaper delivery; because they do not receive *The News*, residents were completely in the dark regarding the open house and the North Lougheed Area Plan.

We would also like to draw to your attention the following facts.

- 1) **The community strongly believes introducing more population density into the area at this time is unfeasible.**

Residents overwhelmingly agree that any additional development must be paused until critical infrastructure and service deficits are addressed, **specifically the completion of the Harris Road underpass and the expansion of Ridge Meadows Hospital. In fact we quote:** "Mayor Stewart regularly voiced these concerns throughout June and August 2025, highlighting that municipalities cannot simply build housing without adequate infrastructure. He also noted that growth requires extensive upfront capital to get "pipes in the ground", roads built, and utility upgrades completed to support the increasing density driven by provincial mandates."

- 2) The Province's suggested housing criteria.
Year 1 (Ends August 31, 2026): 109 cumulative units.
Year 2 (Ends August 31, 2027): 225 cumulative units.
Year 3 (Ends August 31, 2028): 360 cumulative units.
Year 4 (Ends August 31, 2029): 523 cumulative units.
Year 5 (Ends August 31, 2030): 727 cumulative units.



Currently Pitt Meadows is not on the Province's "naughty list". The amount of units that Pitt Meadows has suggested for the North Lougheed Area Plan far exceeds these amounts so it appears the City's plans are a "want" rather than a "need".

3) We call upon Councillor Manion to honour his election promises whereby he stated that he supported protecting nature and farmland to maintain quality of life, stating that development should not destroy natural habitat. As well as he also stated that the "pandemic highlighted the need to preserve and expand our local food supply."

4) It should be noted that Mark Carney has recently stated that too many Canadians rely on imported food at higher prices. He has recently launched a National Food Security Strategy that will help grow and process more food here and put more Canada on Canadian plates which will lower costs, create jobs and build a food system that is more resilient, more competitive and more "our own".

5) The North Lougheed Area Plan area is Eagle habitat and also habitat to Sandhill cranes, herons, racoons, rabbits, bears, eagles, squirrels, coyotes as well as home to many species of birds.

6) Frequent maternity ward closures and severe overcrowding at Ridge Meadows Hospital, (operating at over 108% capacity with limited emergency staff) create unacceptable risks, forcing expectant mothers to travel elsewhere for care. Consequently, the facility cannot safely absorb the population influx proposed by the City of Pitt Meadows.

- **Maternity Diversions:** Staffing shortages have triggered repeated, temporary closures of the labour and delivery unit, requiring patients to be rerouted to alternative Fraser Health Maternity Hospitals.
- **Hospital Strain:** The emergency department is severely overburdened, facing acute parking issues alongside extreme over-capacity operations.
- **Proposed Expansion Risks:** An influx of new residents from Pitt Meadows developments exceeds the hospital's current ability to safely provide care.

7) The housing market is flat and developers are having trouble selling condos and housing units. Many of which are sitting empty with some Developers facing bankruptcy if they cannot sell their product.

8) High living costs drove a record 70,000 residents to relocate from B.C. to more affordable provinces like Alberta and Ontario in 2025. When combined with the regulatory uncertainty surrounding DRIPA legislation, these demographic shifts create a challenging climate that understandably discourages developers from building new housing.

In essence, feedback from local residents reveals overwhelming opposition to the North Loughheed development; the community prefers to maintain its small-town feel and safeguard agricultural land for long-term food security.
