Fire Hall Construction Starts in March

Council is excited to see this project underway, as the new Fire Hall addresses their strategic priority of public health and safety. In December, the construction contract for the new fire hall was awarded to Jacob Bros. Construction is expected to begin in March. The new hall will be built on the site of the old hall, which was demolished last year. The new facility will also house the City's Emergency Operations Centre and is expected to be completed summer of 2022. Pitt Meadows Fire & Rescue Services has been relocated to a temporary fire hall at Pitt Meadows Regional Airport during construction. For more information, visit pittmeadows.ca/newfirehall.

Permit Required for Spring Agricultural Burning (March 1 – May 30)
