



## Daily Log of Noise Concerns

To enable effective investigation and outcome, we require witnesses to provide our Bylaw Officer with a daily log detailing the dates, time and duration of bothersome incidents. The patterns will be discussed with the offender to ideally lead to corrective measures by them.

If the incidents continue, we can issue penalties, but require you to provide direct evidence to the Officer and Adjudicator. Your logs can be used to refresh your memory and provide the Adjudicator with professional and meaningful information. They also convince the Adjudicator progressive efforts have been unsuccessful.
