New Driving Law Has an Impact on Safer Roads

Last December, RoadSafetyBC's 15 day Prohibition Program was replaced with new legislation, and a new RoadSafetyBC High Risk Driving Incident Report (HRDIR) was introduced. This new legislation means that under Section 93 of the Motor Vehicle Act, the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles has the authority to prohibit high risk drivers for a minimum 3 month driving ban, along with other fines and consequences. Some key points to note:



- **40km to 59km/hr over the posted limit** results in a \$368 fine, 3 penalty points and an immediate 7 day vehicle impoundment
- **More than 60km/hr over the posted speed limit** results in a \$483 fine, 3 penalty points and an immediate 7 day vehicle impoundment
- **Second offence** results in fines and consequences above plus a 30 day immediate vehicle impoundment
- **Any subsequent offenses** will result in fines and consequences above plus a 60 day immediate vehicle impoundment
- **In all cases of excessive speeding** the High Risk Driving Incident Report may be submitted to the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles for further action
