Spring Agricultural Burning

Open wood burning is not permitted at anytime, anywhere in urban areas in Pitt Meadows (per Bylaw No.2688). This includes outdoor fireplaces /cooking pits. Burning of vegetative matter is allowed on Agriculturally Zoned Properties only with a permit. **You can obtain a burning permit online at mypittmeadows.com** or in-person at City Hall (12007 Harris Road).
