City Closes Facilities, Playgrounds and Cancels Events to Prevent Spread of COVID-19

In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the City has made the decision to close City facilities, playgrounds and to cancel events, arts and recreation programs, rentals and use of sports fields by organized groups. All registered programs and facility bookings that are cancelled will be issued a credit to the customer's account. If you would like to request a refund, please email parksandrec@pittmeadows.ca. The intention of these closures and cancellations are to ensure the safety of residents by limiting gatherings where social distancing can't be controlled. The City is actively monitoring updates from local, provincial and federal health authorities and is committed to taking further action as directed by these agencies to protect the safety of residents. Following recommendations from the Police Services Review and community feedback received, Council has voted unanimously to take the next step forward in creating an independent RCMP detachment to improve service and safety. Once formal approvals from the RCMP and the Province are received, implementation of the transition plan could take up to three years and will include a one-time capital investment for facility space.
