Property Taxes Are Due on July 2, 2020



2020 Property Tax Notices are being mailed to all Pitt Meadows Property Owners with important information. As part of the COVID-19 Financial Relief Grant, a one-time grant of \$150 for a single-family home and \$100 for a multi-family home will be automatically applied to every private individually owned tax account with a Class 1 Residential designation. There is no need to apply. To waive your grant, send an email with the subject line: "Waive Grant" to

pmtaxes@pittmeadows.ca and include your folio number and access code. Property Taxes and Provincial Home Owner Grants are due July 2, 2020. Late penalty fees for taxes have been postponed until October 1, 2020. However, residents are encouraged to pay their taxes by the due date to ensure the City has sufficient cash flow to operate without borrowing from reserves. A 10% penalty will be charged on outstanding taxes as of October 1, 2020. For more information, visit pittmeadows.ca/taxes.
