Everyday objects discarded as waste are reimagined into remarkable works of contemporary art and sculpture in *The Art of Upcycling* at the Pitt Meadows Art Gallery. This year's exhibit hopes to raise awareness about excess plastic waste that ends up in the oceans. Pieces include a 2D map sewn together with recycled plastics and fabrics, beautiful jewellery hand-crafted from reclaimed plastics along the Pacific Rim shores and playful sculptures created from a variety of upcycled materials. New Fire Chief to Oversee Fire Hall Replacement

Council has decided to rebuild the fire hall on the existing site, following months of careful analysis. The new facility will replace the existing hall, which no longer meets the needs of Pitt Meadows Fire Rescue Service and has a number of safety risks and operational hazards for crews. Overseeing the new fire hall replacement project will be a top priority for new Fire Chief, Mike Larsson. A request for proposals has been posted for preliminary design.
