RapidBus Arrives in Pitt Meadows in 2020

Mayor Bill Dingwall spoke on behalf of Council and the community at a recent Translink announcement for the new RapidBus service coming to Pitt Meadows in 2020. "Whether commuting for work, travelling for pleasure or simply getting from point A to B, the Lougheed RapidBus will quickly and efficiently connect the communities of Pitt Meadows, Maple Ridge, Port Coquitlam and Coquitlam to the Coquitlam Central Station Skytrain," said Mayor Dingwall.
