## City Launches Campaign to Reduce Illegal Dumping.

## Council this Month

### Council Votes Unanimously to Enhance Industrial Design Guidelines

After extensive review and public consultation, Mayor and Council voted to amend Bylaw 2758, 2017 to include the Development Permit Area No. 4 -Industrial Guidelines (South Harris Business Park Design Guidelines). These guidelines consider public concerns and outline a shared vision for the development of the Golden Ears Business Park Phases 3 & 4. The guidelines promote innovative form and character designs that are thoughtful and includes enhanced streetscapes, pedestrian/cyclist paths and connections, greenways, articulated steps, buffers, screening, signage and lighting plans and more. "These guidelines allow us to meet the needs of the community as best we can and will ensure a high quality business park that is much more integrated into the surrounding neighbourhood" said Mayor Bill Dingwall.

## Watering Restrictions are Starting on May 1

**From May 1 to October 15, Stage 1 watering restrictions are in effect.** This means residents can only water lawns on specific days and times. For residential lawn watering: even-numbered addresses Wednesday/Saturday mornings 4 am to 9 am; odd-numbered addresses Thursday/Sunday mornings 4 am to 9 am.
