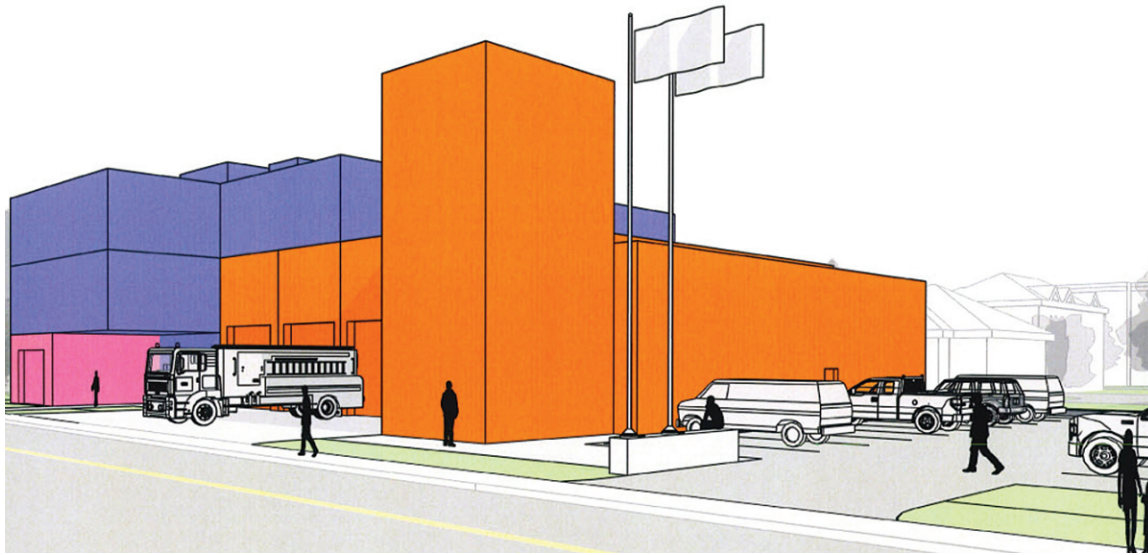

Council advocates for transportation and agriculture at UBCM Convention

Mayor and Council attended the annual Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) convention the week of September 23. The annual convention is an opportunity for local governments to come together, learn, share ideas and lobby the provincial government about important issues for the community. Council met with several ministries including: the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure to request road and transit improvements and with the Ministry of Agriculture to advocate for funding to support local farmers and to review new Agriculture Land Commission regulations.
