Kennedy Road Overpass Paused; Harris Road Underpass is Now the Primary Focus

City Council, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority, and Canadian Pacific (CP) have agreed to temporarily pause work on the Kennedy Road overpass. Priority is being given to the Harris Road underpass as the critical grade separation given its importance to the community to ensure improved safety and access for citizens, businesses and first responders.

Council has not approved the project that is still in the planning and design phase. This spring, the port authority will provide an update on the CP rail component of the project, and share the results of a related noise study and next steps. Public engagement in the fall will include the proposed design for the Harris Road underpass and information about the relocation of the heritage buildings. Feedback from the fall engagement will be used to finalize the design and will be shared with the community. Learn more at pittmeadows.ca/roadandrail.

Council Selects Preferred Site for Future RCMP Detachment in Pitt Meadows

šxʷhéḱ ʷnəs

'the place to remember him, her, it, them'
[Spirit Square]

xcəwás

'front (waterside) of the house'
[Waterfront Commons Park]
