City's Advisory Design Panel Reviews GEBP Phases 3 & 4

The design of the Golden Ears Business Park (GEBP) Phases 3 & 4 remains an important initiative for the City. In an effort to provide the best-possible business park, the City's Advisory Design Panel (ADP) will assess proposed plans in relation to enhanced industrial design guidelines. The drawings were introduced at the ADP meeting on May 13, 2020. The ADP will continue to meet until they have completed their review. Tune in to watch upcoming virtual meetings from 2-4pm on June 10 & 24 and July 8 & 22 at pittmeadows.ca/adp. The community will be able to provide their thoughts at an upcoming EPC meeting.

North Lougheed Study Area (NLSA) Update

Council received a report from staff on May 26, 2020, including: the proposed NLSA land use plan, designations and policies, and a summary of the second phase of public and stakeholder engagement, which took place between November 2019 and February 2020. Council asked staff to incorporate some changes to the land use plan and to revisit the development policies. Staff will return to Council in late June or early July with a revised land use plan and development policies for further review. Learn more at pittmeadows.ca/NLSA.

After a year-long review and extensive consultations with the community and various stakeholders, Council approved a transition plan towards an independent RCMP Detachment in Pitt Meadows.
