### Make it a Safe Summer on the Water!

Pitt Lake is the second-largest freshwater tidal lake in the world. We're lucky to have this beautiful treasure in our own back yard for everyone to enjoy safely.

#### Before heading out on the water, remember these safety tips:

- Get your boating licence. You must carry proof of competency while operating a pleasure craft.
- Check your boat and safety equipment before departing.
   Always have a Marine Safety Kit on board.
- Don't boat impaired. It's dangerous and illegal to operate a boat while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

- Share the waterways. Be aware of wildlife, swimmers, and other watercraft.
- Always wear a properly fitted personal flotation device (PFD). You must carry a PFD or life jacket for each passenger.
- Maintain a safe speed and don't race on the lake.

The more safety measures you take, the more you might save.
