Make it a Safe Summer on the Water!

Pitt Lake is the second-largest freshwater tidal lake in the world. We're lucky to have this beautiful treasure in our own back yard for everyone to enjoy safely.

Before heading out on the water, remember these safety tips:

- Get your boating licence. You must carry proof of competency while operating a pleasure craft.
- Check your boat and safety equipment before departing. Always have a Marine Safety Kit on board.
- Don't boat impaired. It's dangerous and illegal to operate a boat while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

- Share the waterways. Be aware of wildlife, swimmers, and other watercraft.
- Always wear a properly fitted personal flotation device (PFD). You must carry a PFD or life jacket for each passenger.
- Maintain a safe speed and don't race on the lake.

The more safety measures you take, the more you might save.
