The Block Watch program brings neighbourhoods together to build a sense of community and ensure that knowledge regarding crime prevention techniques and reporting are used to create a safer, crime free neighbourhood for all. Each neighbourhood has a captain and co-captain who work closely with a coordinator who helps support the program and provides training regarding crime prevention strategies and how to report a crime. This information is shared with the neighbourhood participants. Reporting suspicious activity and crime within the area allows for local police to allocate the correct resources to the correct areas, which overall enhances community safety.
