Harris Road Underpass Project Partnering Agreement (PPA)

Council endorsed the signing of the PPA to allow progress on the design of the Harris Road underpass with future consultation planned with the community. The underpass will improve public safety and response times for police, fire and ambulance services. Council, staff and the community have also achieved more noise and vibration mitigation than initially offered with the potential to increase mitigation further if additional funding is secured.

Autonomous RCMP Detachment Approved

After three years of extensive review, research and consultation, the City has received approval from the Province and is transitioning towards an autonomous RCMP Detachment in order to provide enhanced police visibility, public safety, service levels and responsiveness in Pitt Meadows.

City Celebrates Amenity Land Transfer of Ownership

The transfer of Onni's Amenity Land contribution was recognized with an official ribbon cutting. The contribution consists of an additional 13 acres of green space adjacent to the Pitt Meadows Athletic Park (eight acres of parkland and five acres of an enhanced trail network), with an estimated value of \$22.5 million. The detailed plans for this parkland will be a priority for the new Parks, Recreation and Culture Advisory Committee in 2022.
