Council This Month

The Future of Transportation in Pitt Meadows. On January 9, the Gateway Transportation Collaboration Forum (GTCF) presented a number of proposed railway infrastructure projects to Council which included a Kennedy Road Overpass and a Harris Road Underpass. These proposed projects are currently being reviewed by the federal government for funding. Council continues to advocate for the best interests of the community and will review funding outcomes in the context of the priorities and interests of Pitt Meadows. Following the federal funding decision, expected in April, opportunities for citizen input and feedback will be part of the next steps. Find out more pittmeadows.bc.ca/transportation.

Go Green

Zero Waste. Throughout 2018, the City's Green Leadership Team is promoting topics relating to Zero Waste. This month we're talking about green waste and why it's important to keep organics out of the garbage. Food and other organic materials in the garbage create methane, a powerful greenhouse gas that adds to global warming when layers of waste can't decompose properly.
