Have Your Say: Rail Crossing Infrastructure Public Input



Last month, the federal government announced a \$55.8 million federal investment infrastructure project bundles including an addition of nearly 5km of track paralleling the existing rail track throughout Pitt Meadows, a four lane underpass at Harris Road, and construction of a two-lane over pass at Kennedy Road. The City of Pitt Meadows is hosting an engagement session on June 25, 2018 from 4pm to 8 pm at the Heritage Hall for residents to provide input, specifically on rail grade separation projects. Council This Month

Golden Ears Phase 3 & 4 Bylaws Adopted. On May 22, Council adopted zoning amendments to facilitate the development of the Golden Ears Business Park Phase 3 & 4. Community benefits include 13 acres of park land in South Bonson with an estimated value of \$22.5 million; an enhanced trail network; additional tax revenues estimated at \$2 million; and opportunities for job creation. Council will develop a community interface committee to proactively engage on construction impacts on neighbourhood livability, a first in Pitt Meadows. Terms of reference will be developed for this new committee and immediate neighbour consultation will occur during the development permit process in future years.
