Visit the City at the Home Show



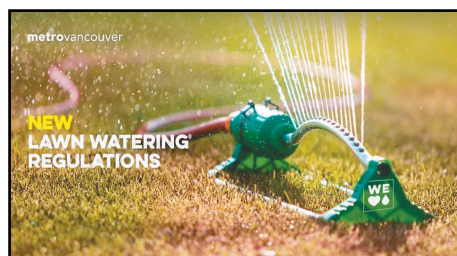

New Lawn Watering Regulations in Effect May 1



Metro Vancouver has updated the Water Shortage Response Plan with a new plan, called the Drinking Water Conservation Plan, active as of May 1, 2018. It includes changes to the water use regulations, and largely impacts the watering of lawns and gardens, playing fields and golf courses, and the operation of commercial car washes and pools. For residential lawn watering, even-numbered addresses Wednesday, Saturday mornings 4 am to 9 am; odd-numbered addresses Thursday, Sunday mornings 4 am to 9 am.
