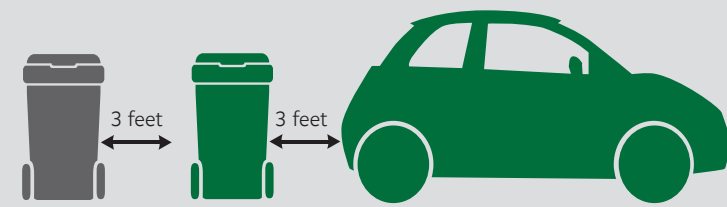


Waste Management is pleased to provide these guidelines to help make it easier to use our services.



COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Place containers at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Not the night before.
- Place containers three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward the street. The arrow on the lid pointing to the centre of the road.
- Place containers at least three (3) feet from obstructions such as cars, trees, fences, mailboxes. Our trucks need clear access to empty containers.
- Place wheels as close to the curb as possible. On the roadway, not the sidewalk.
- Write your address on your cart.
- Rinse your carts with vinegar and water to neutralize odors and kill bacteria.

GARBAGE IS COLLECTED BI-WEEKLY PROUDLY SERVICED BY WASTE MANAGEMENT OF CANADA

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

- **Always bag all garbage before placing in cart.** Residents are responsible for cleaning up any loose garbage scattered as the result of animals, wind or vandalism.
- Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust and extinguished ashes.
- Maximum weight is 20kg/44 lbs. Overweight and oversized containers will not be accepted.
- Limit is 1 cart bi-weekly (STRICTLY ENFORCED).
- You may put up to 2 extra bags if accompanied by extra bag tags – available at City Hall & Shoppers Drug Mart.

NOT ACCEPTED These items are not accepted in your garbage cart

- Recyclables. Visit www.recyclebc.ca for information and collection schedule.
- Dirt, rocks, gyproc, cement, steel or wood
- Building/demolition material
- Liquids
- Uncontained animal waste
- Any hazardous or noxious matter
- Medical Waste
- Electronics banned by the Greater Vancouver Regional District
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- Clean wood and organics. Banned from garbage.
- Food and yard waste
- Styrofoam
- Paint
- Batteries

FOOD AND YARD WASTE

All of these materials can go into your green food and yard waste cart

No plastic bags, including those labeled "compostable" or "biodegradable"

Food Scraps



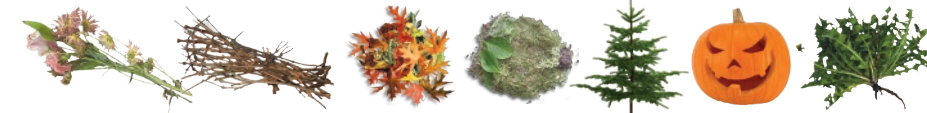
Meat, fish, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers

Food-Soiled Uncoated Paper



Coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, uncoated paper (non-shiny), soiled paper bags, kitchen paper towels, paper napkins, non-coated paper plates.

Plants, Flowers and Yard Debris



Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, grass clippings, weeds, twigs, leaves, branches (under 4 feet long, 4 inches in diameter), jack-o-lanterns and holiday trees (no decorations or flocking).

FOOD AND YARD WASTE IS COLLECTED WEEKLY

FOLLOW THESE EASY TIPS FOR COMPOSTING:

1. Line your kitchen container with newspaper.
2. Fill it with kitchen scraps, unwanted leftovers and food-soiled paper.
3. Empty the container into your yard/food waste cart frequently.
4. Layer food scraps with yard waste and newspaper in your cart to absorb liquids.



NOT ACCEPTED These items are not accepted in your food and yard waste cart

- **Dirt or rocks**
- Plastic or compostable bags,
- Containers, cups (paper or plastic)
- Styrofoam
- Metal or foil
- Clean wood
- Glass
- Cotton balls or swabs, diapers, wipes
- Cigarettes or butts
- Vacuum dust or bags
- Pet waste and pet litter
- Building material
- Liquids
- Cooking Oil
- Produce Stickers

NO BIO-DEGRADABLE OR COMPOSTABLE PLASTIC STYLE BAGS PERMITTED, PLEASE USE ONLY PAPER BAGS
